

Computer Policy Error

In this post, I will show you how to fix below error when you try to run gpupdate /force command.



Above machine was not able to update computer policy. I tried restarting the system and ran gpresult report as well. The report indicated below error



So, started to look for a fix through google. The solution is as follows...

Go to C:\Windows\System32\GroupPolicy\Machine and rename Registry.pol to Registry.bak
