
How to remove CMG and other stuff from Current Branch 2010


In this post, I will go through the process of removing CMG, Co Management, CDP and other stuff. The reason why, I am removing is due to cost. On an average, I am spending over **\$250 per month** just to maintain these stuffs without any bandwidth transfer. It is getting too expensive so, it is time to pull the plug for CMG. Below are current CMG configuration within CB2010.



Removal Steps:

- 1. Cloud Management Gateway
- 2. CMG Role Server and Site role
- 3. Co-Management
- 4. Azure Active Directory Tenants
- 5. Azure Portal App Registration Client App and Server App
- 6. Azure Services
- 7. Delete any resources pertaining to CMG in Azure Portal









CMG role is removed as well when we deleted Cloud Management Gateway




Now we delete Co-Management




Now it is time to remove Server and Client app from Azure Active Directory Tenants and Delete the Tenant as well




Remove these from Azure Portal – Azure Active Directory – App Registrations





Now it is time to remove User and Group Discovery from Azure Services and delete the services as well




With all the above steps we have completely removed CMG and its stuff from Current Branch 2010 console.
