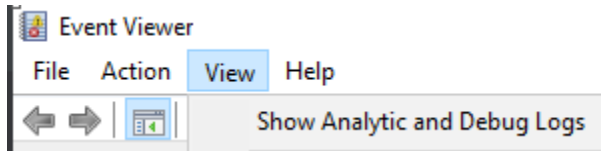


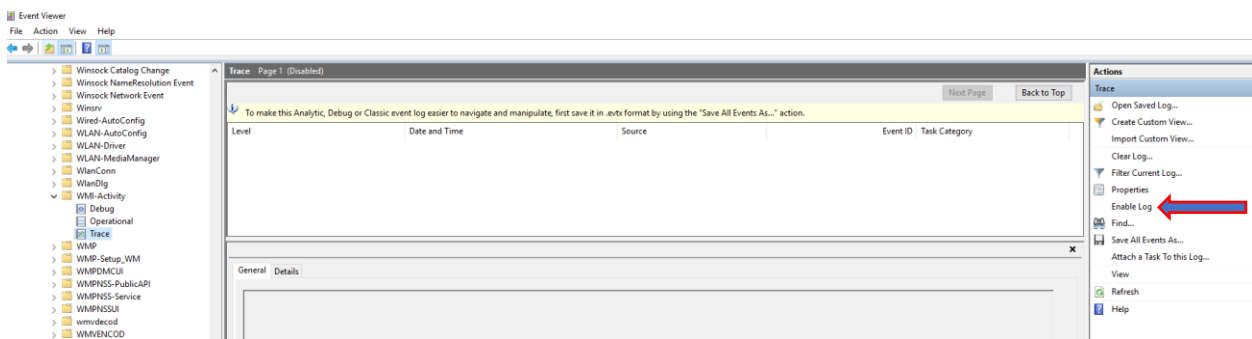
How to enable WMI Logging

In this post, I will show you how to enable and disable WMI logging within Windows. The reason for enabling, if you want to troubleshoot WMI script deployed within your network. Without the logs it is not possible to troubleshoot and fix the issue WMI script.

Open Event Viewer – Click Show Analytic and Debug Logs



Expand Applications and Service Logs – Microsoft – Windows – WMI Activity – Trace -Click Enable Log



Event Viewer

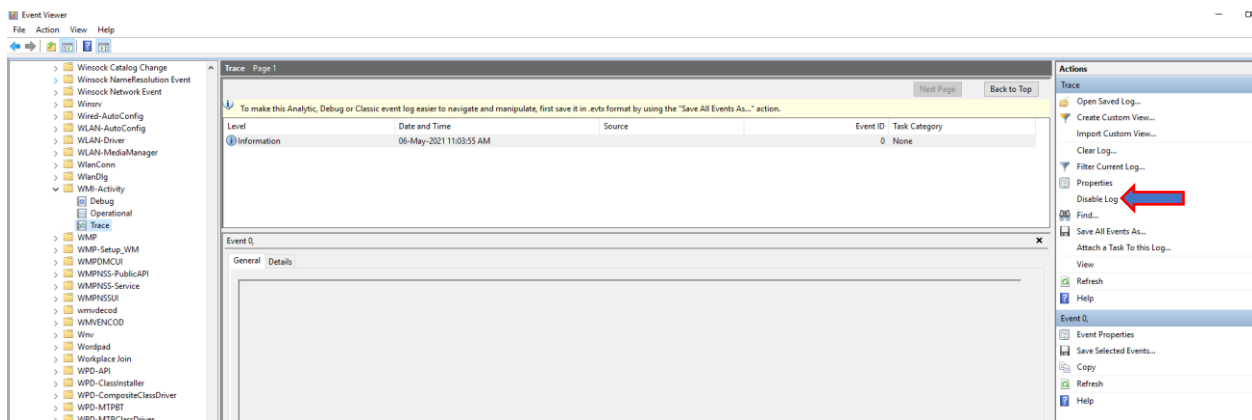


Analytic and Debug logs may lose events when they are enabled. Do you want to enable this log?

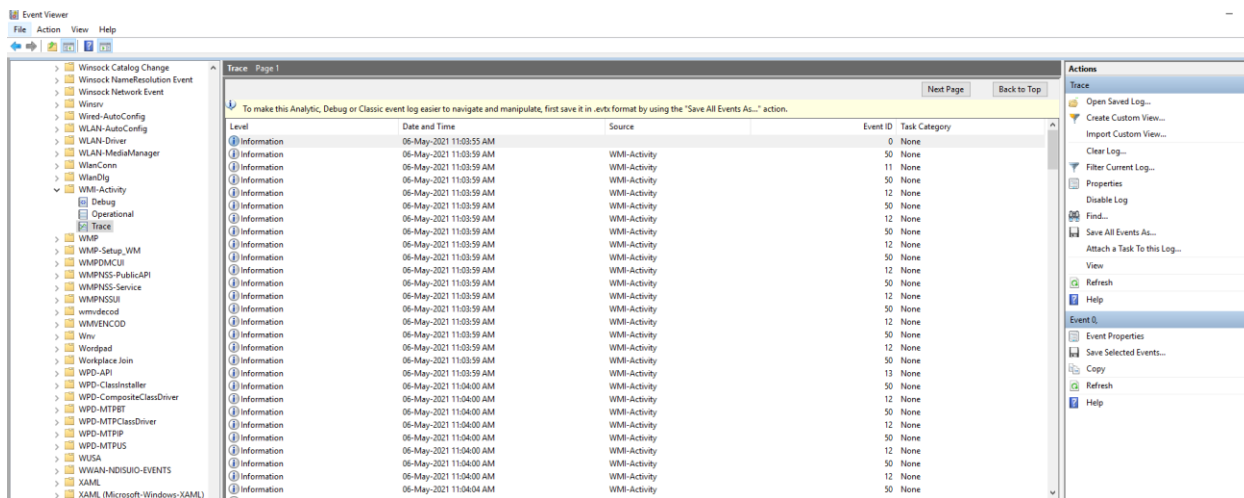
