

# How to install macOS Ventura on unsupported mac hardware

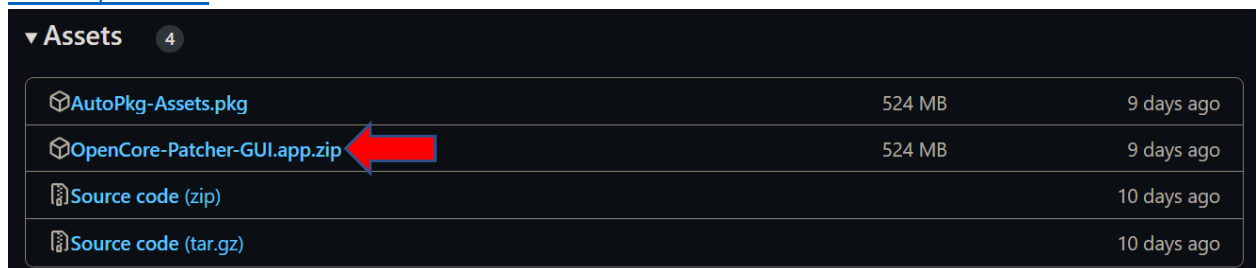
In this post, I am going to show you how to install Ventura on unsupported mac hardware running Monterey.

I have MacBook Pro 2013 model. I will be using this mac to install Ventura. Before you start make sure to perform full backup of macOS. There is no going back after we install Ventura. I am not going to do a backup because, I do not have any important files.



Following will be the steps:

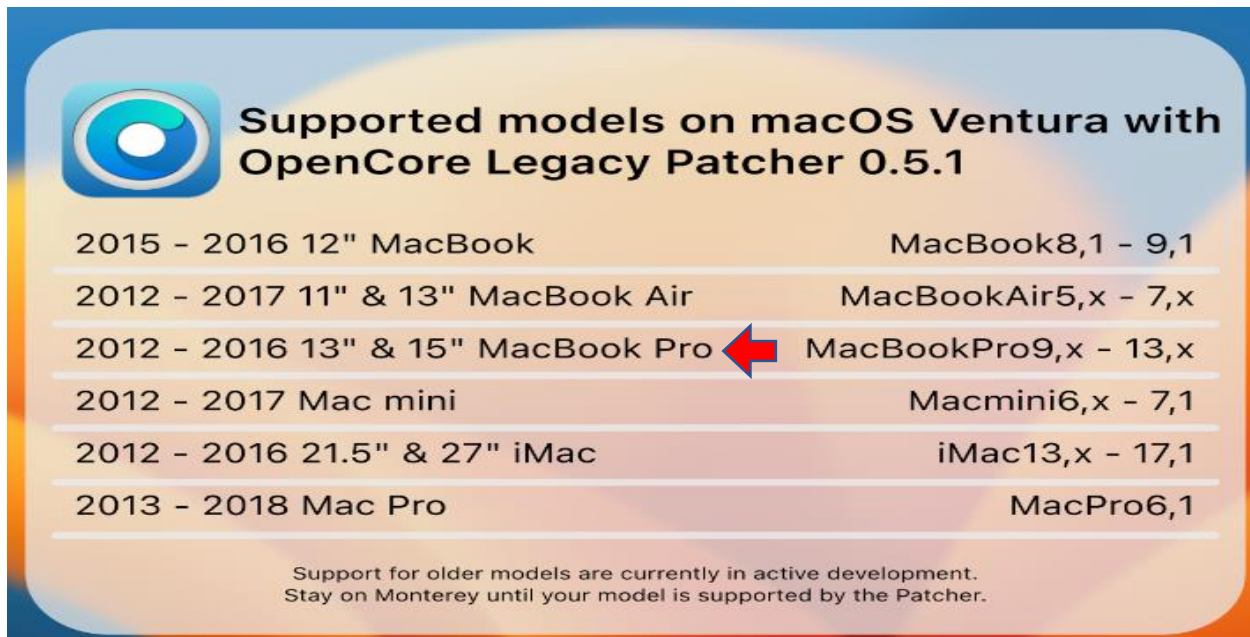
1. Download OpenCore Legacy Patcher - <https://github.com/dortania/OpenCore-Legacy-Patcher/releases> -



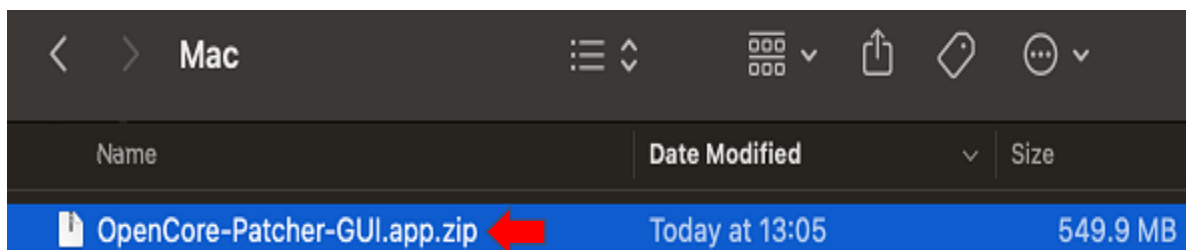
2. Open the patch file
3. Follow the steps
4. Plug in USB stick – 16GB
5. Perform the install
6. Reboot and install available patches

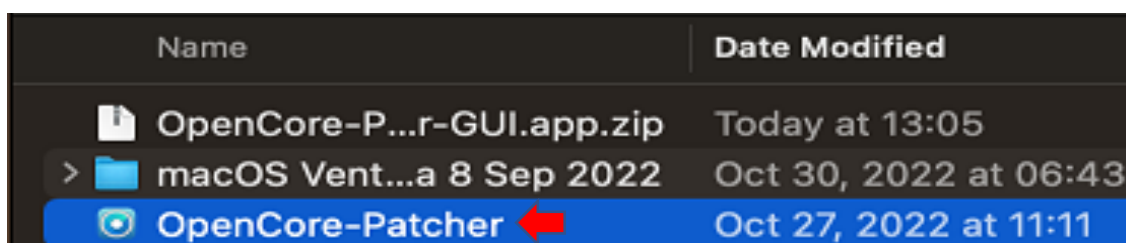
Double Click OpenCore-Patcher-GUI.app.zip



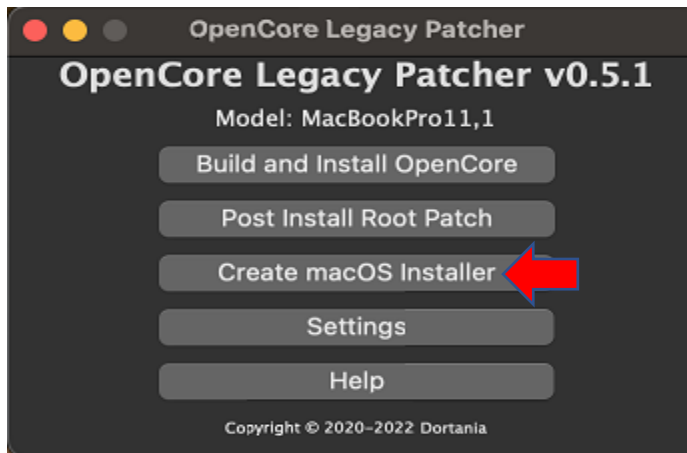
Wait for the archive to expand



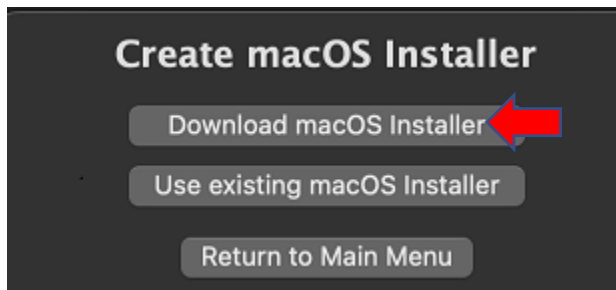
Click OpenCore-Patcher



Create macOS Installer



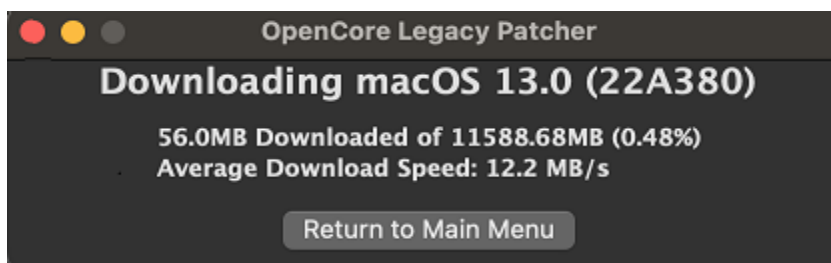
Download macOS Installer



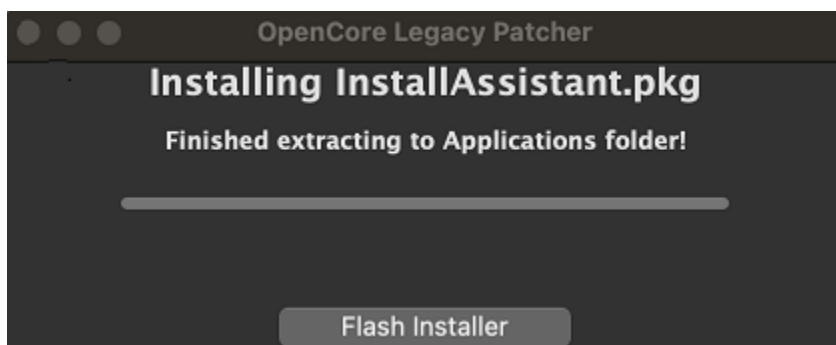
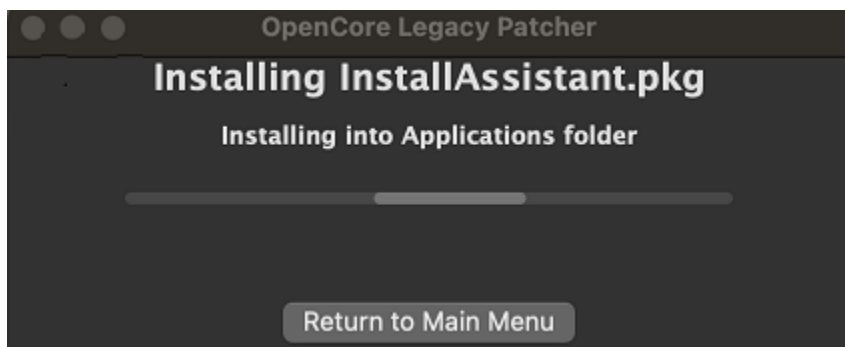
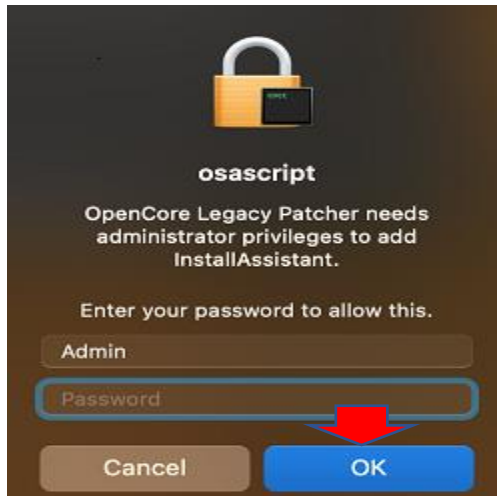
Select macOS 13.0



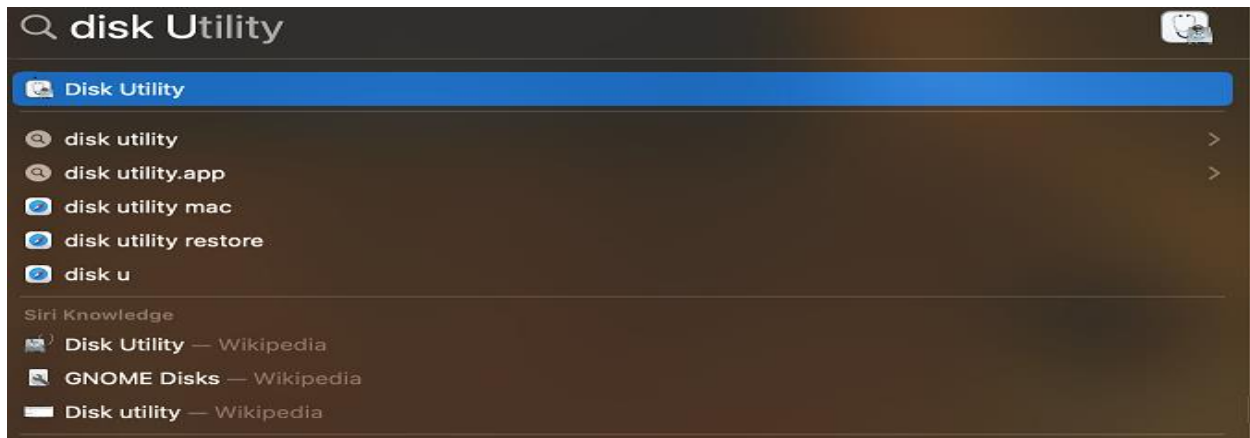
Wait for the download to complete. It can take about 30-45 minutes to download.



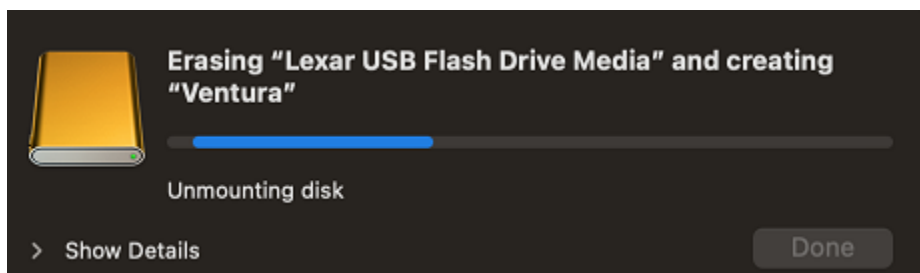
Allow access to OpenCore

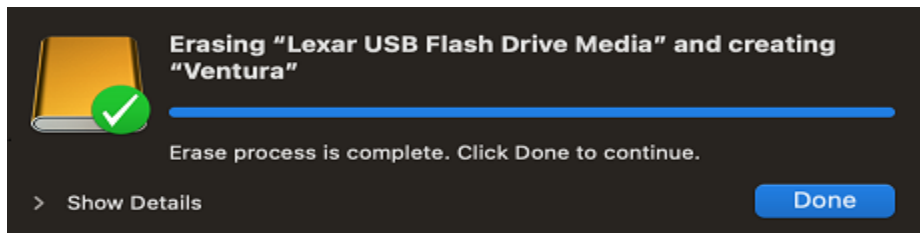
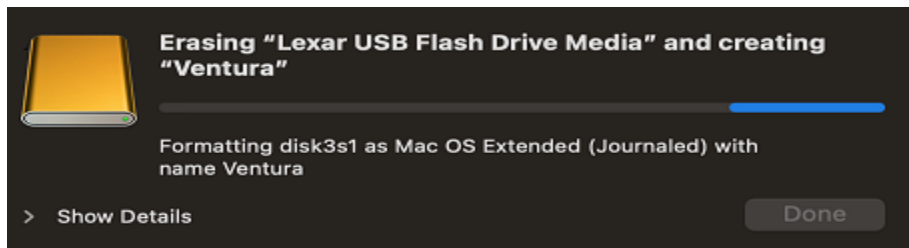


Plug in USB stick 16GB – Click Search button and type Disk Utility

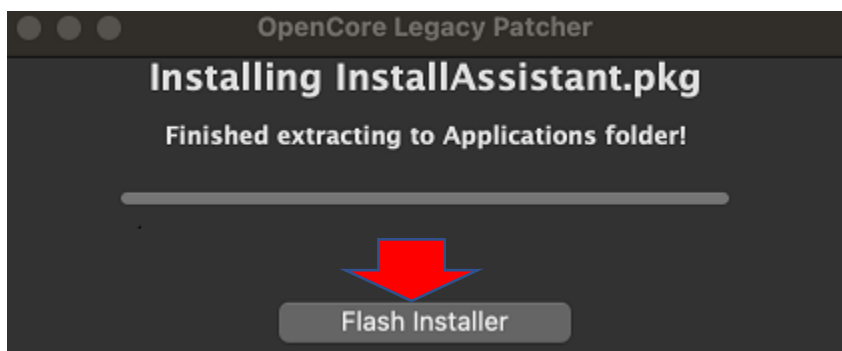


Select USB stick and click Erase

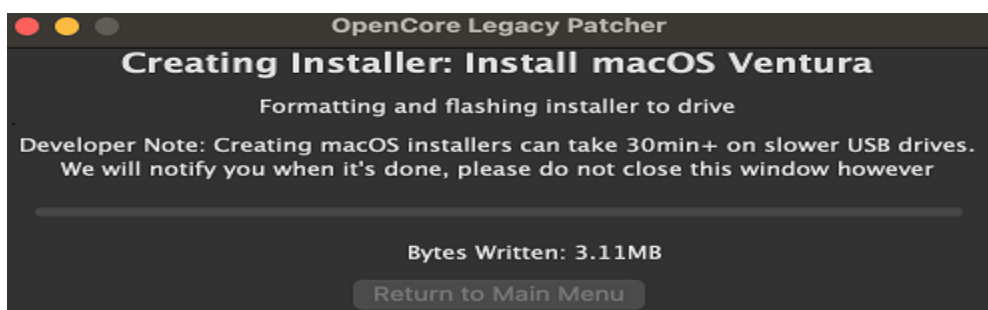


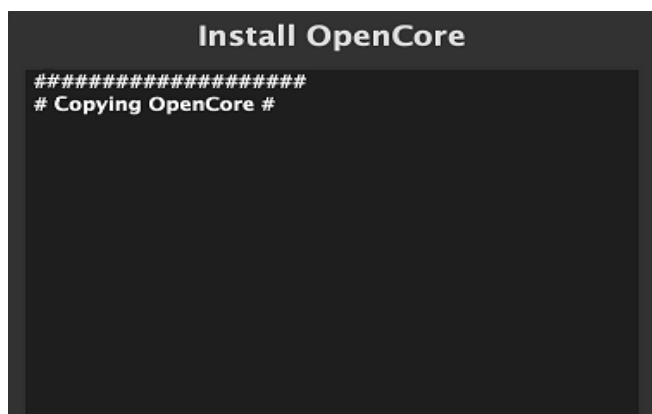
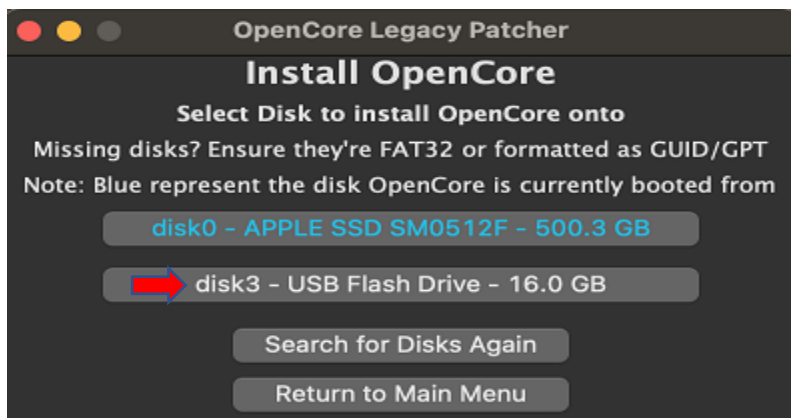
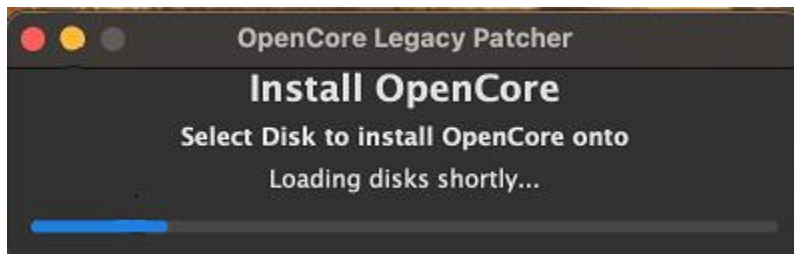
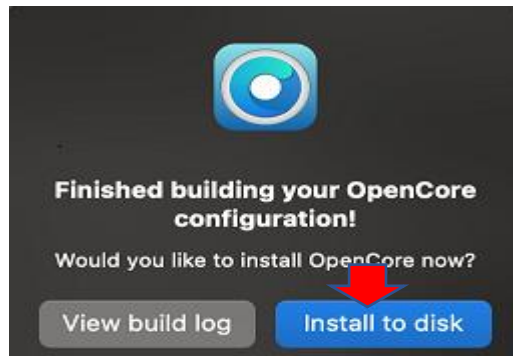


Click Flash Installer

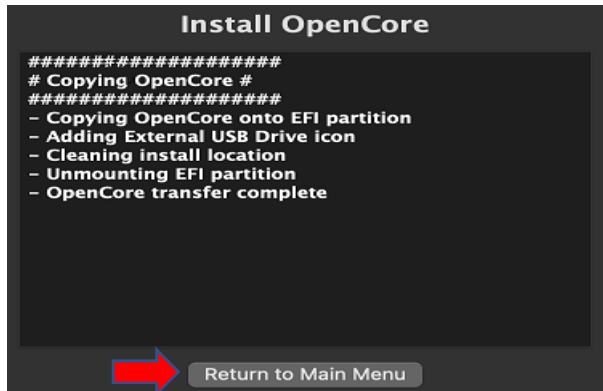


The installer will create macOS installer Ventura on USB stick which will be used to boot later





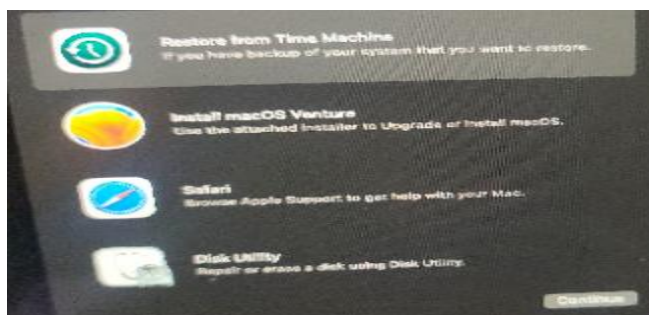




Now power on the mac and hold Option button. Select EFI Boot – the USB stick

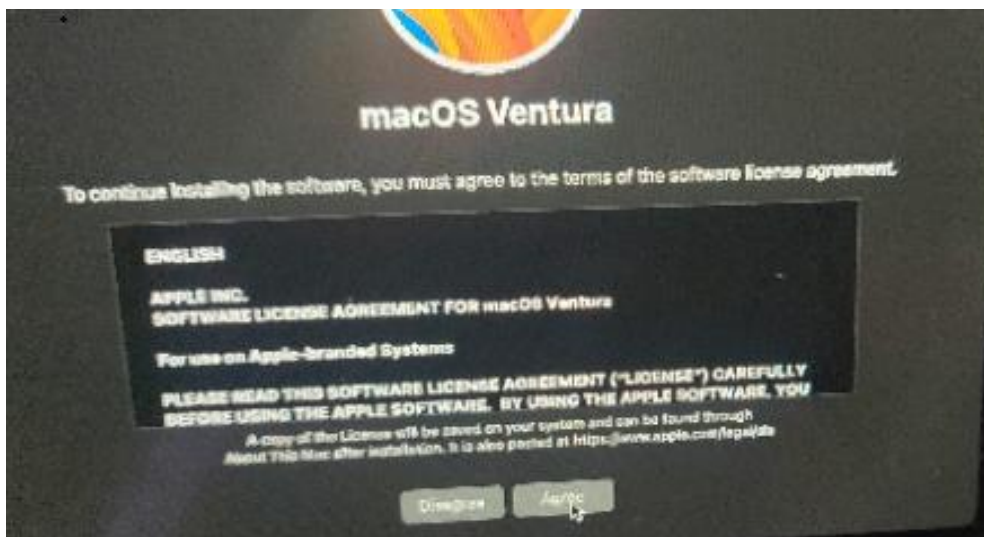
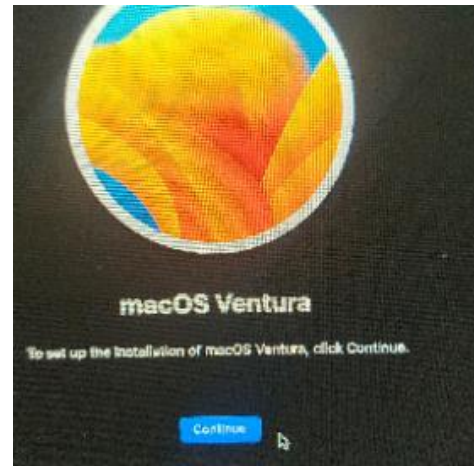
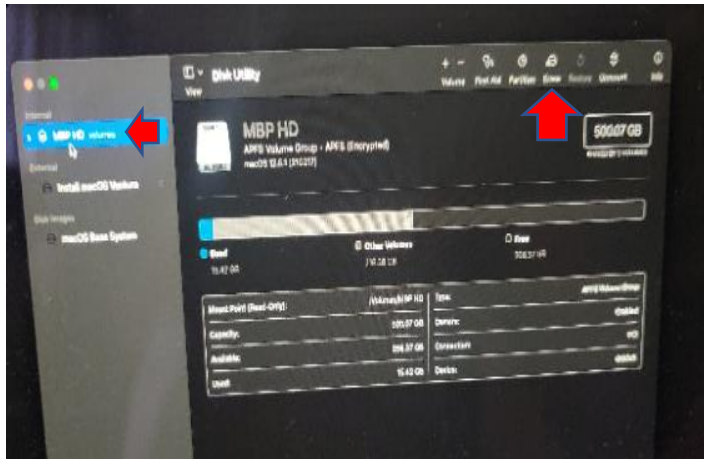


Wait for it to load. You will see this screen. Select Disk Utility

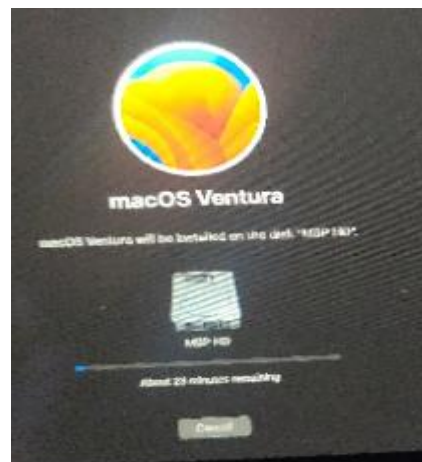




Select mac HD – Erase and exit Disk Utility. Select macOS Ventura – click Continue

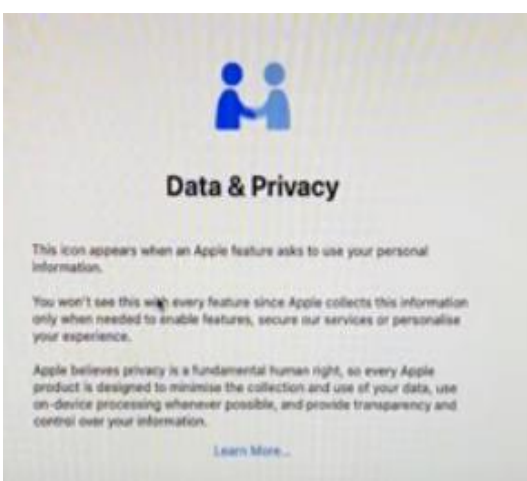
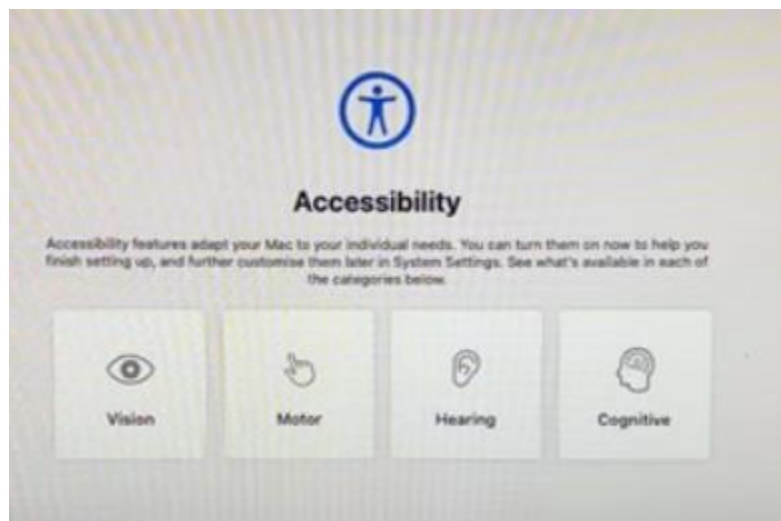
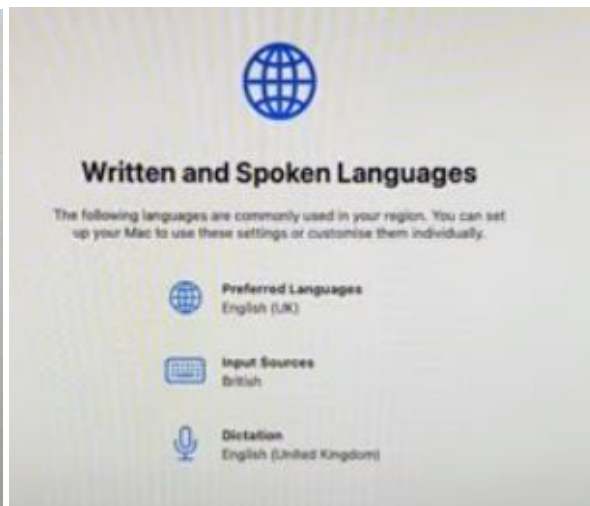


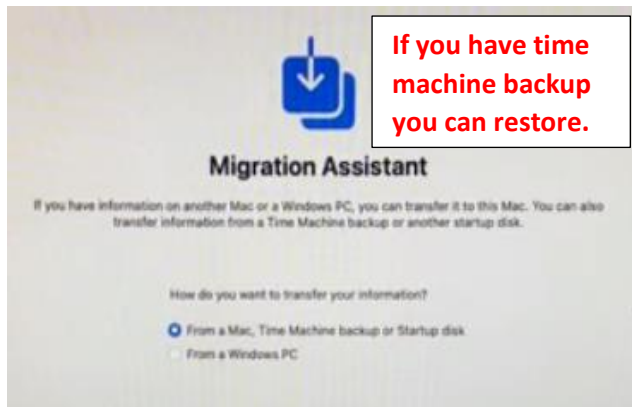
Select mac Hard Disk



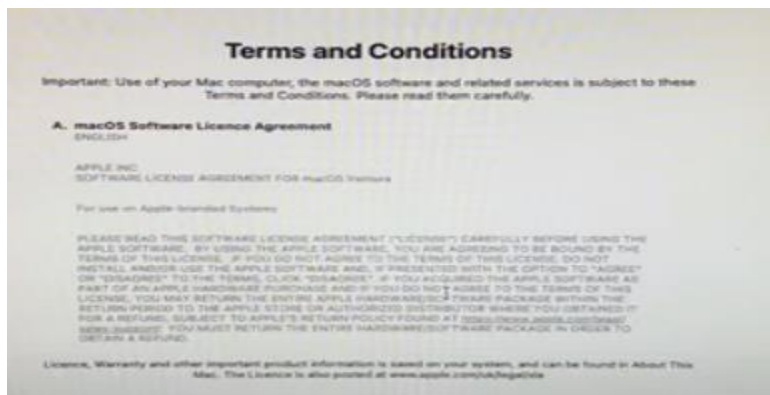
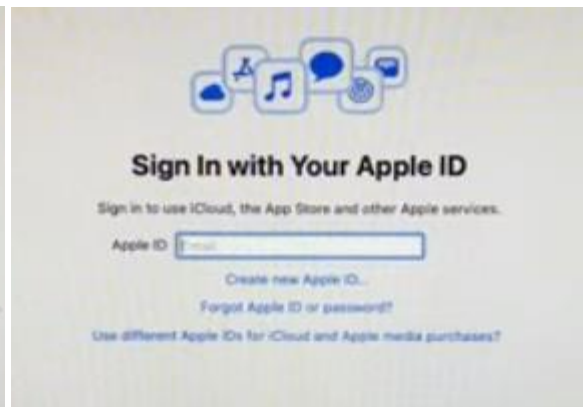
The system will reboot 3-4 times and will take about 30-45 minutes for the process to complete.

Follow below screen and complete final setup

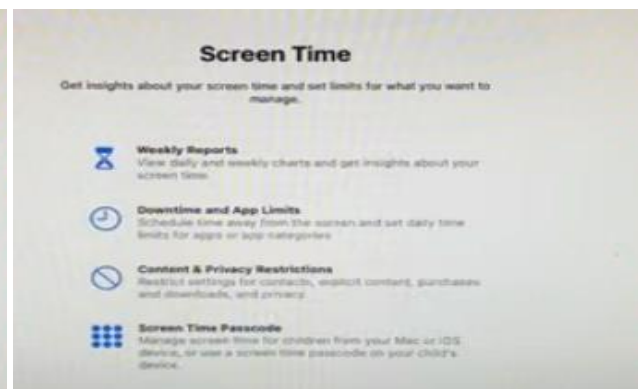
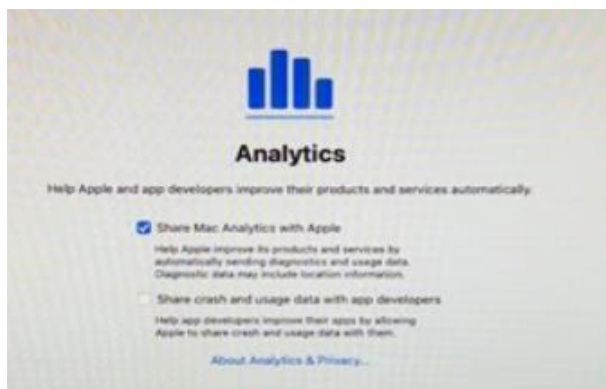
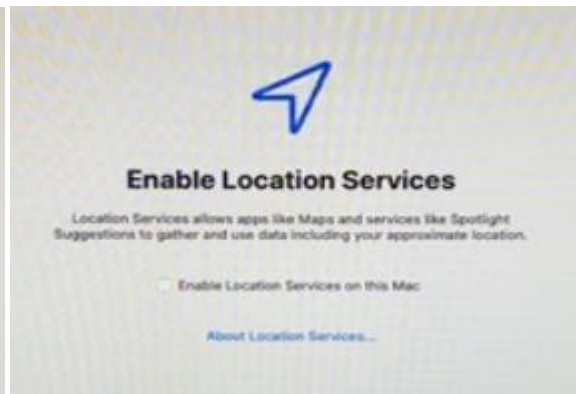
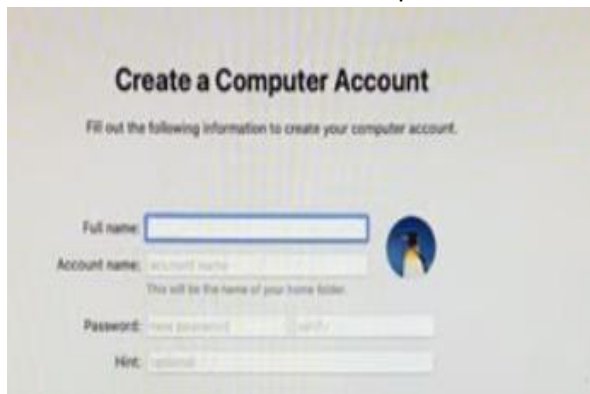




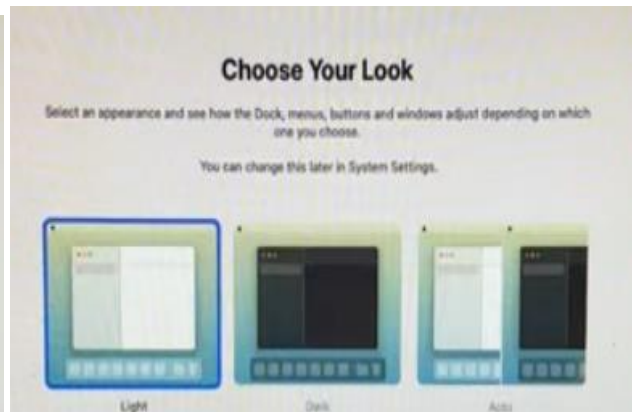
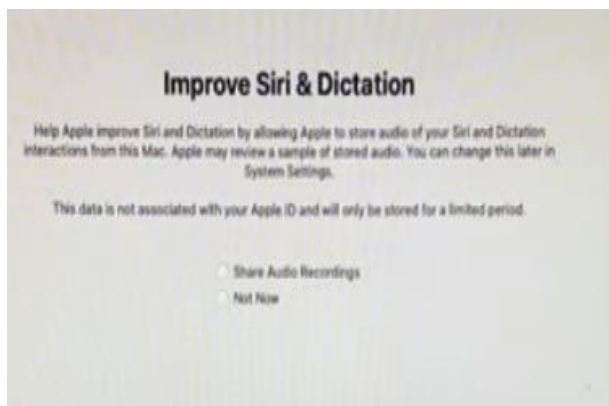
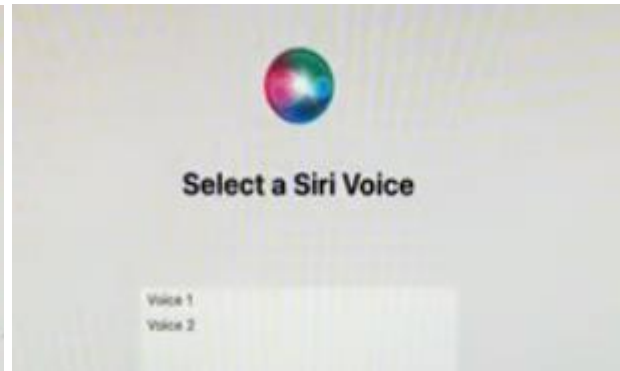
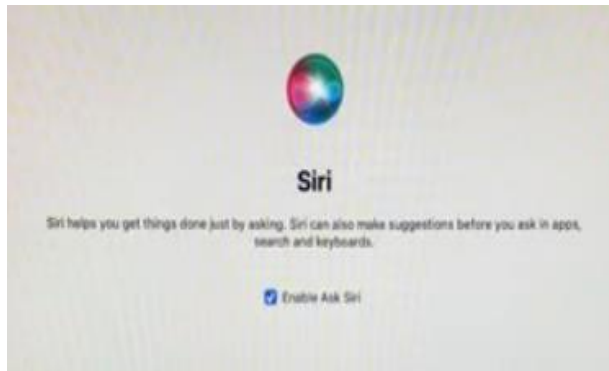
If you have time machine backup you can restore.



Crete Admin account and create password for admin account

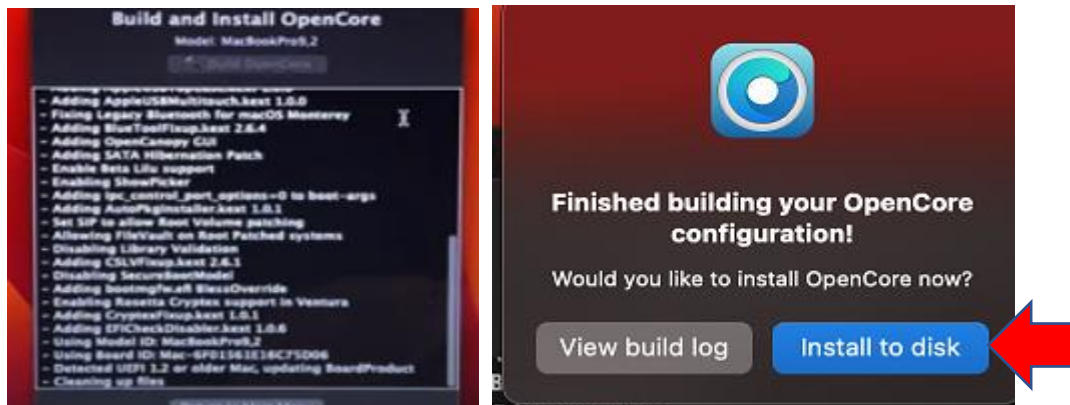




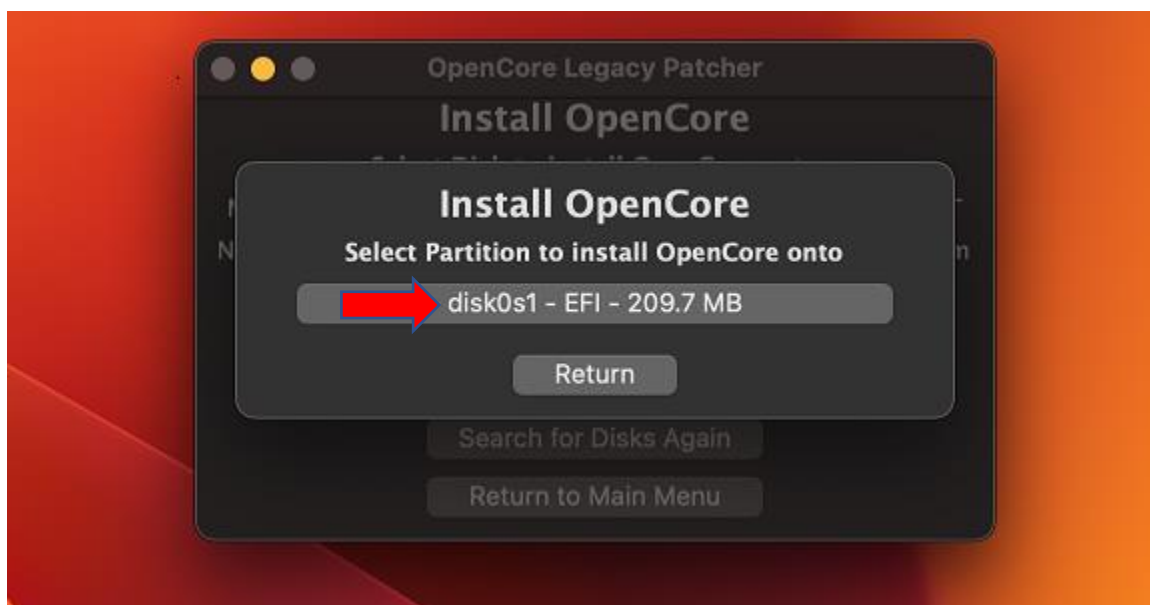


Now login with Admin account. After that wait for few seconds for a pop up window to show up like this

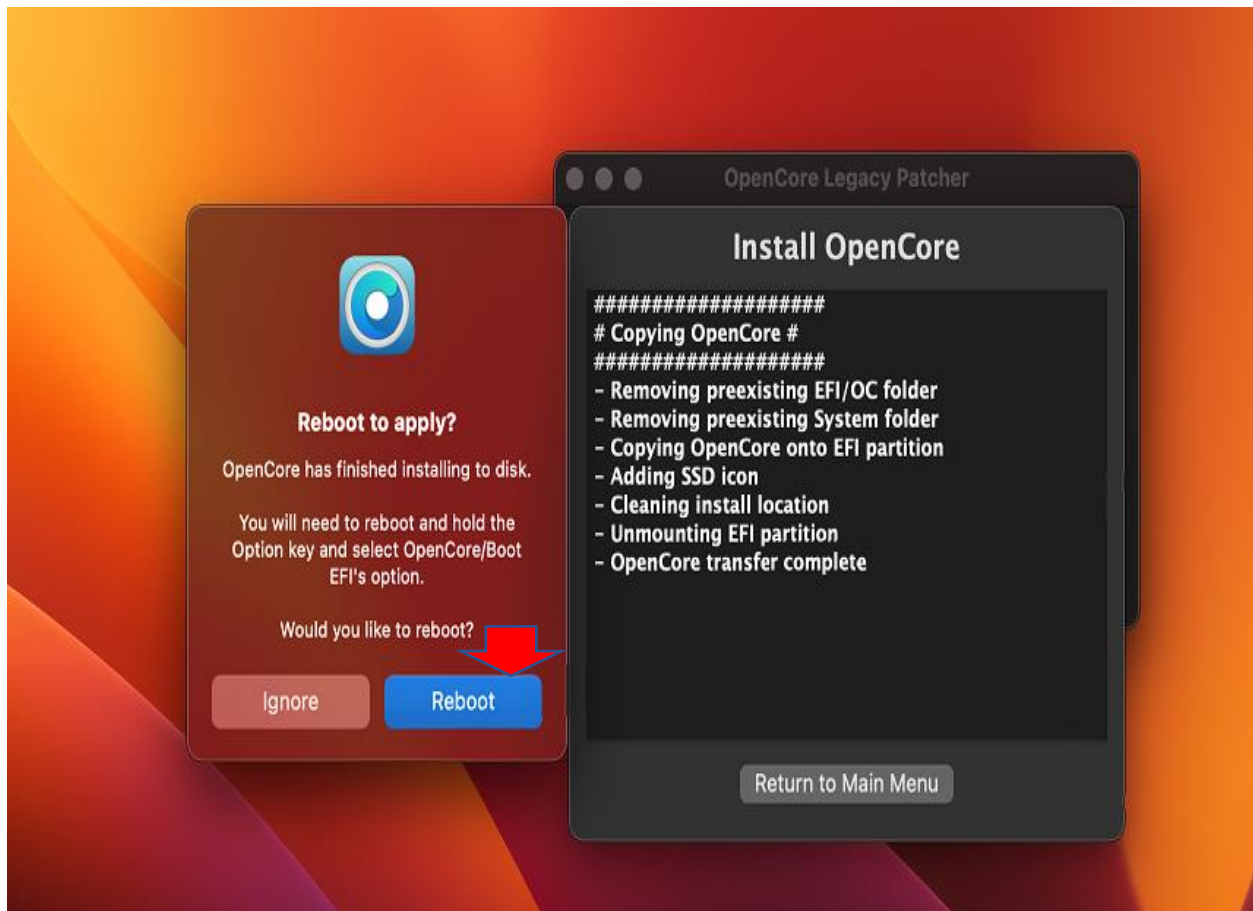




Now we are going to select mac HD. We want mac HD as the primary boot for macOS Ventura



Before you click reboot – make sure to Eject “Install macOS Ventura USB stick”

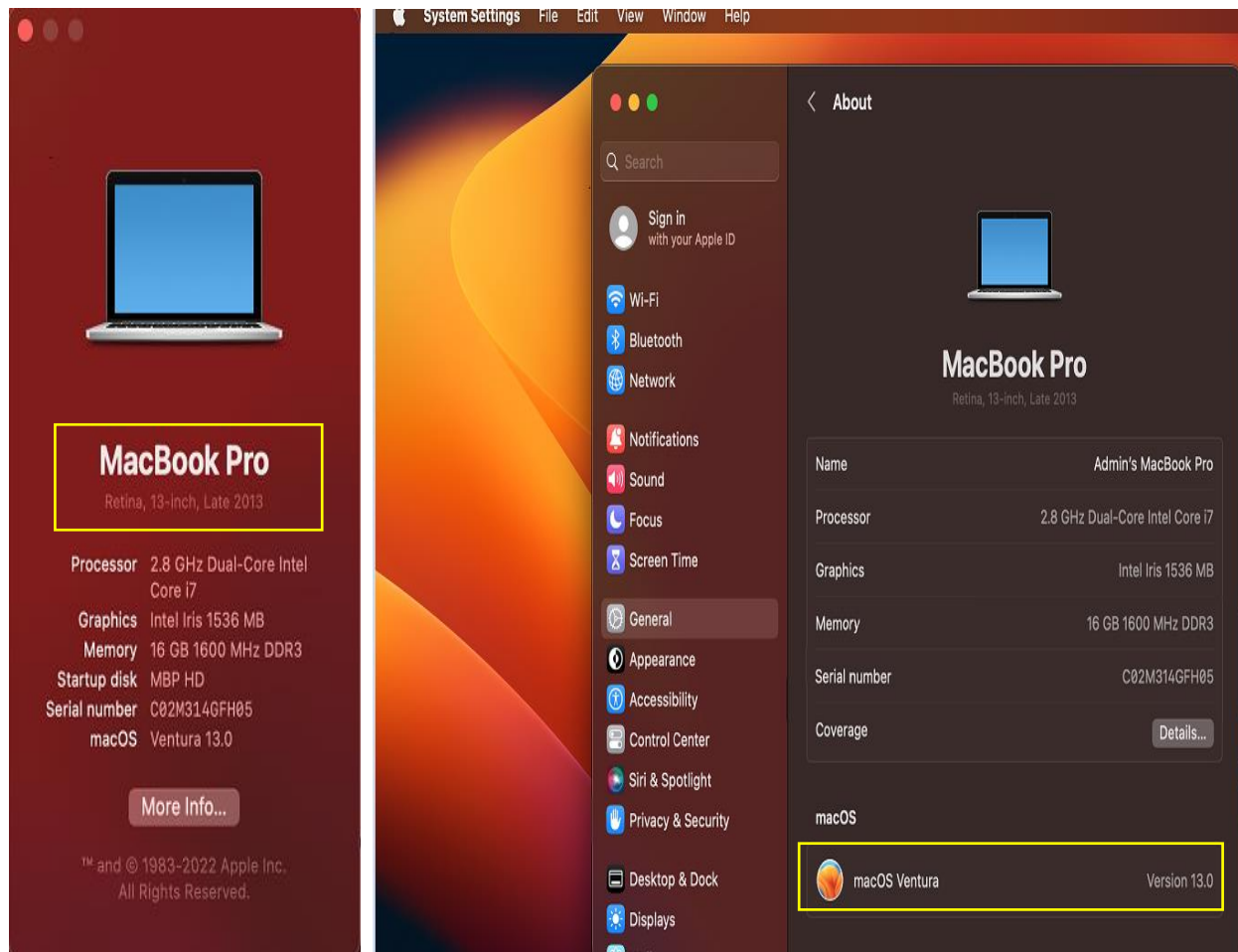


The system will reboot and will load from mac Hard disk. Now login and enjoy the new OS.
