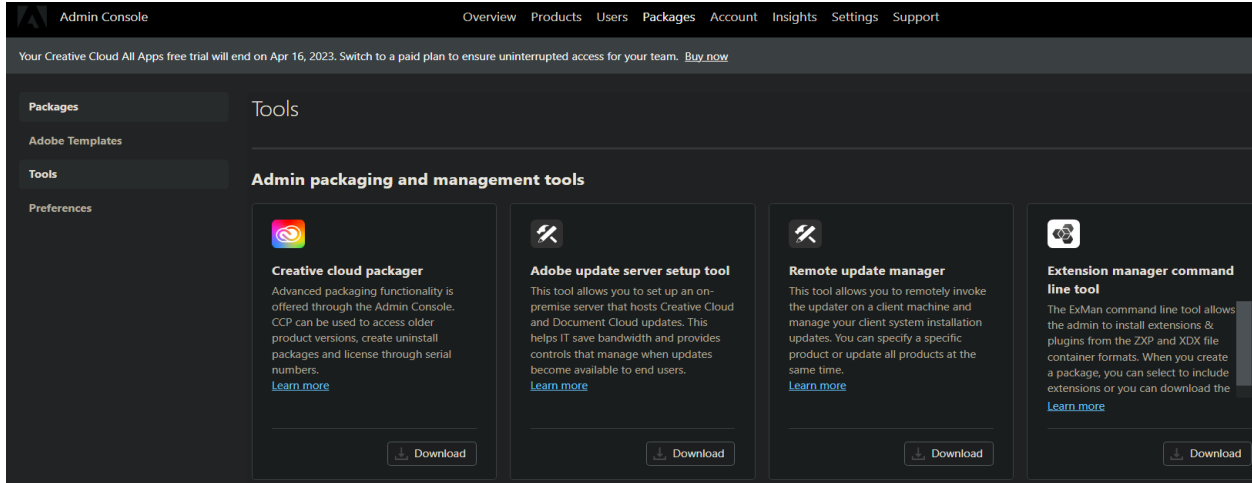


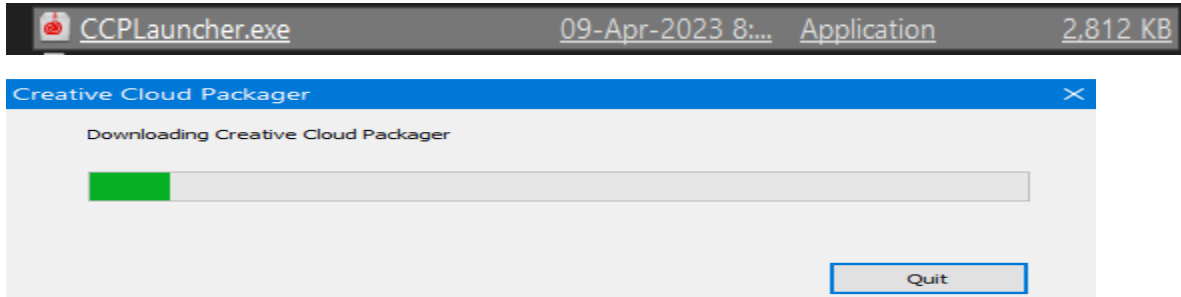
# Deploying Adobe CS/PS using Configuration Manager

In this post, I am going to share the steps on how to deploy Creative Cloud Suite package using Configuration Manager. We will create application package and deploy to Adobe collection with one window 10 device. After that we will patch the application with latest release.

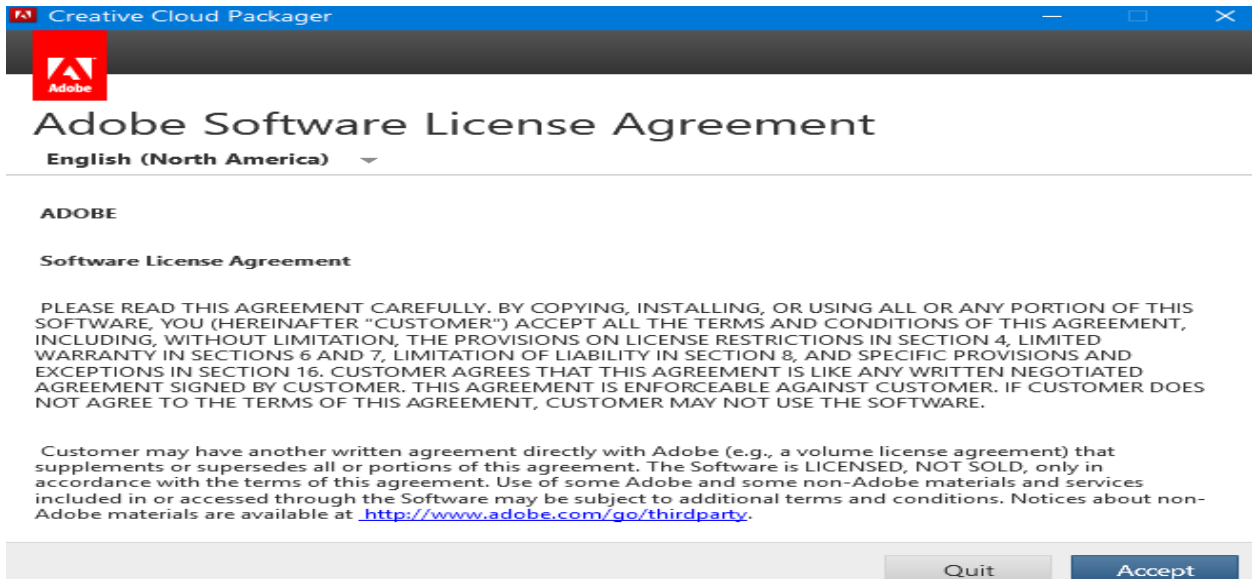
The steps are a bit different when compared to Intune deployment. First you login to Adobe Admin Console with USERID and PASSWORD. If you don't have one you can create one at Adobe site. After that Click Packages -> Tools -> Creative Cloud Packager -> Download for Windows




Run the exe
