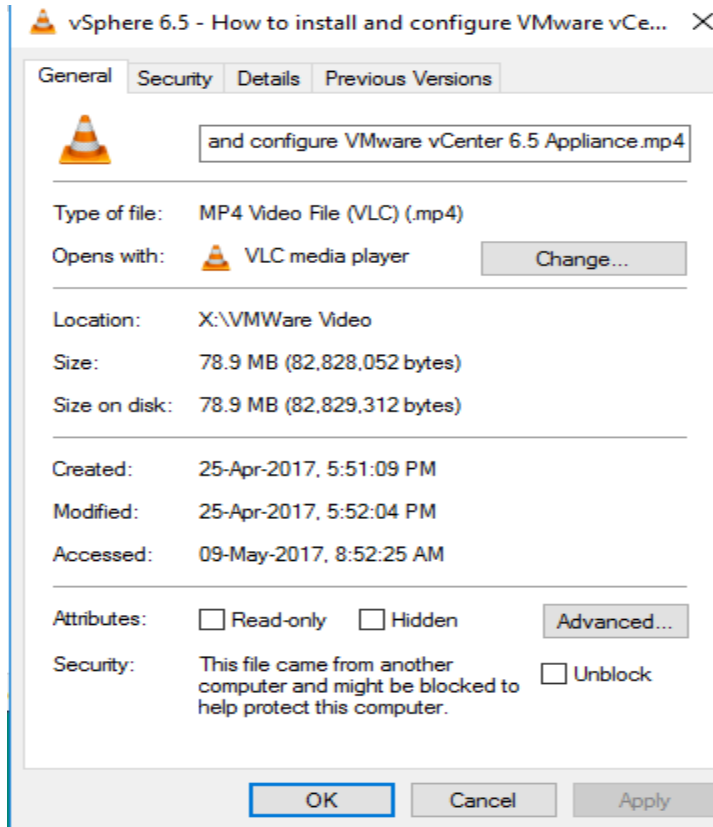
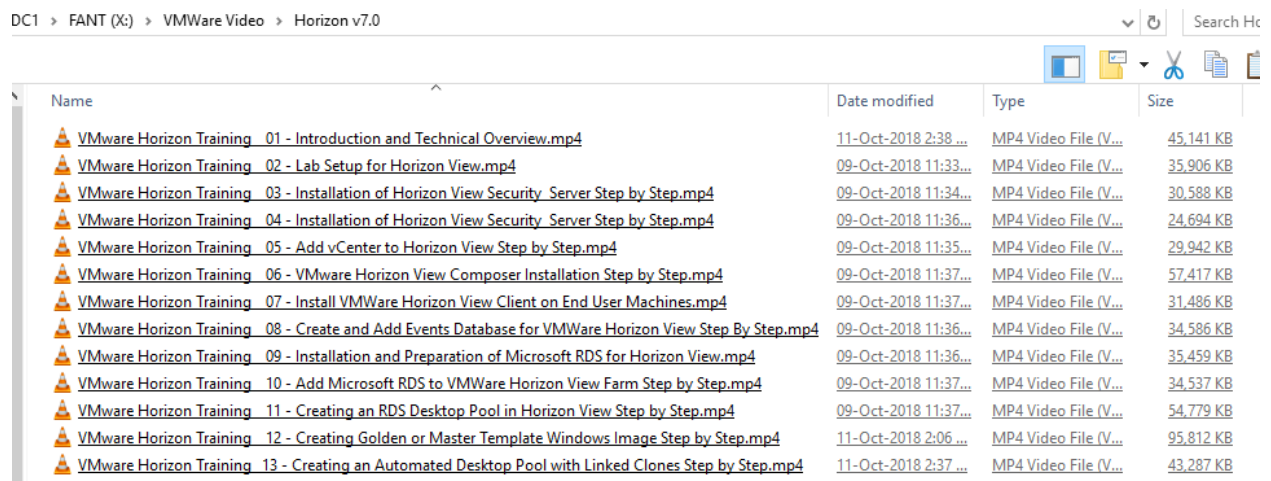


How to unblock all the files in a folder?

You might have come across this when you download files from internet.



In my example below, I have over 13 files inside a folder called Horizon v7.0



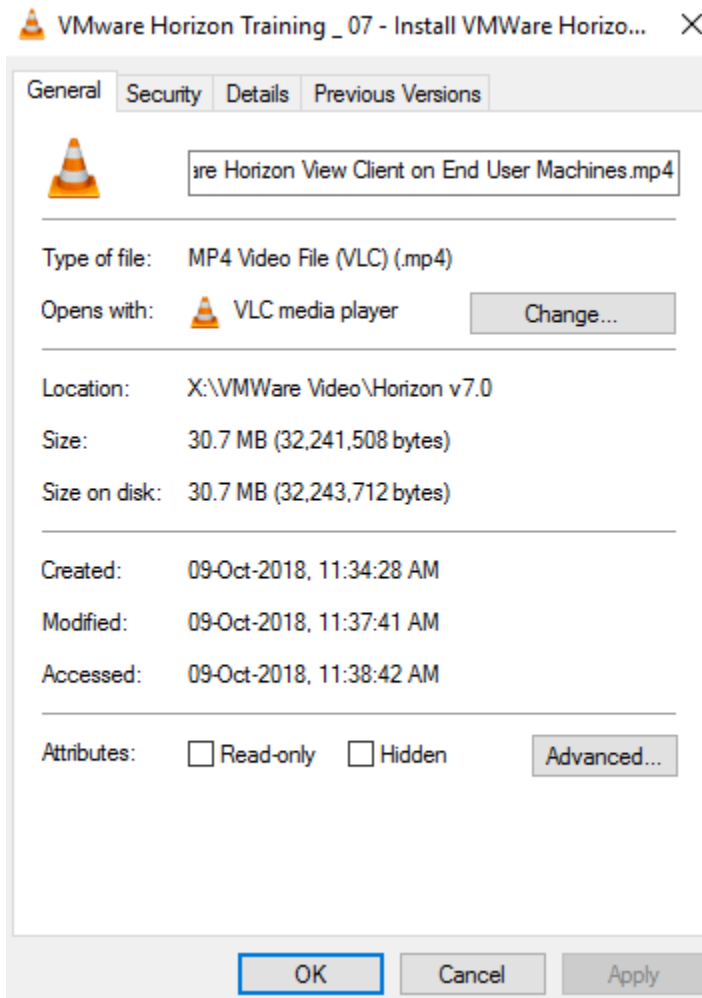
I don't want to go through the process of unblocking each files. We can achieve this using PowerShell command to unblock all the files within the folder.

Open PowerShell – Go to the folder where the files are located that you want to unblock and run this command

Get-ChildItem -Path 'x:\vmware video\horizon v7.0\' | Unblock-File

```
PS X:\VMWare Video\Horizon v7.0> Get-ChildItem -Path 'x:\vmware video\horizon v7.0\' | Unblock-File
PS X:\VMWare Video\Horizon v7.0>
```

Now right click any files and go to the properties – you will see the following



That is it!
