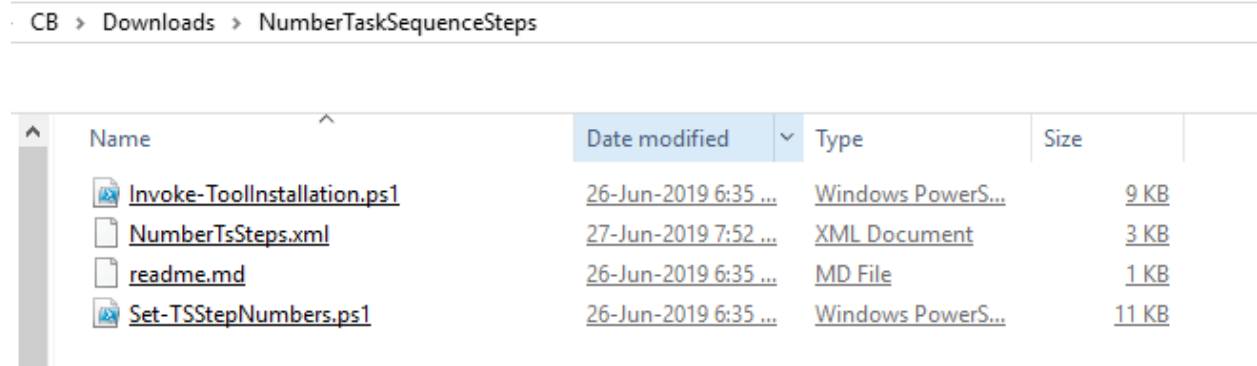


# Install Console Extension for Task Sequence Step Number

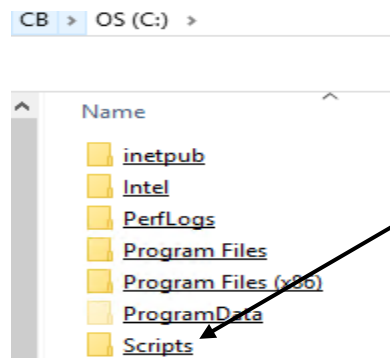
In this post, I will show you how to install console extension for task sequence step number. This can be used for existing and future task sequence.

You can get the script from here - <https://wetterssource.com/number-your-task-sequence-steps>

Close the console first and copy NumberTaskSequence file to site server.

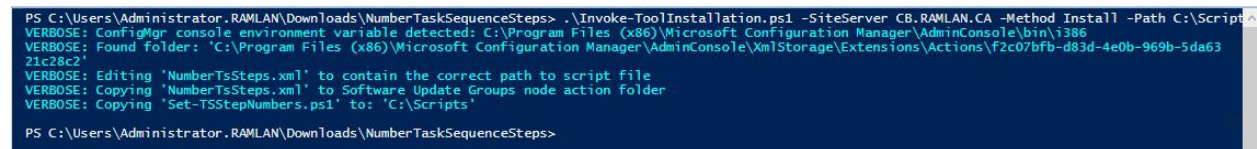


After that create a folder on the root of C and call it Scripts



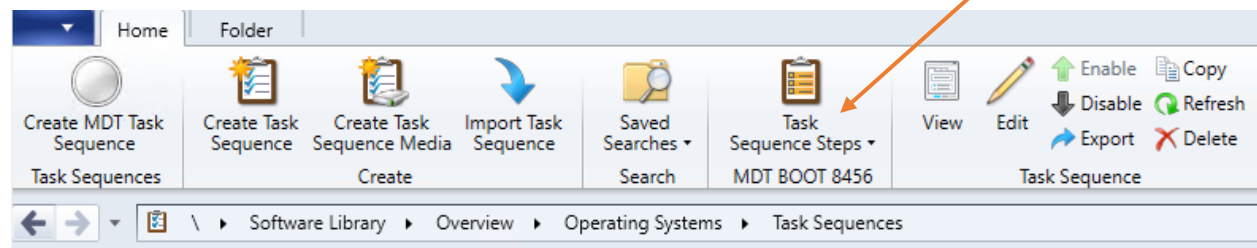
Open PowerShell as Admin and run the following command:

```
.\Invoke-ToolInstallation.ps1 -SiteServer CB.RAMLAN.CA -Method Install -Path C:\Scripts -Verbose
```

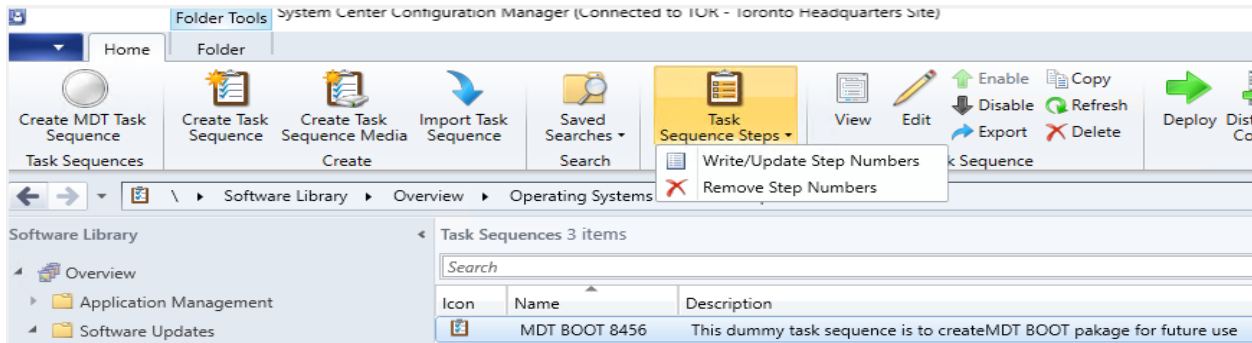


You should see above output. If something is wrong you will get error message.

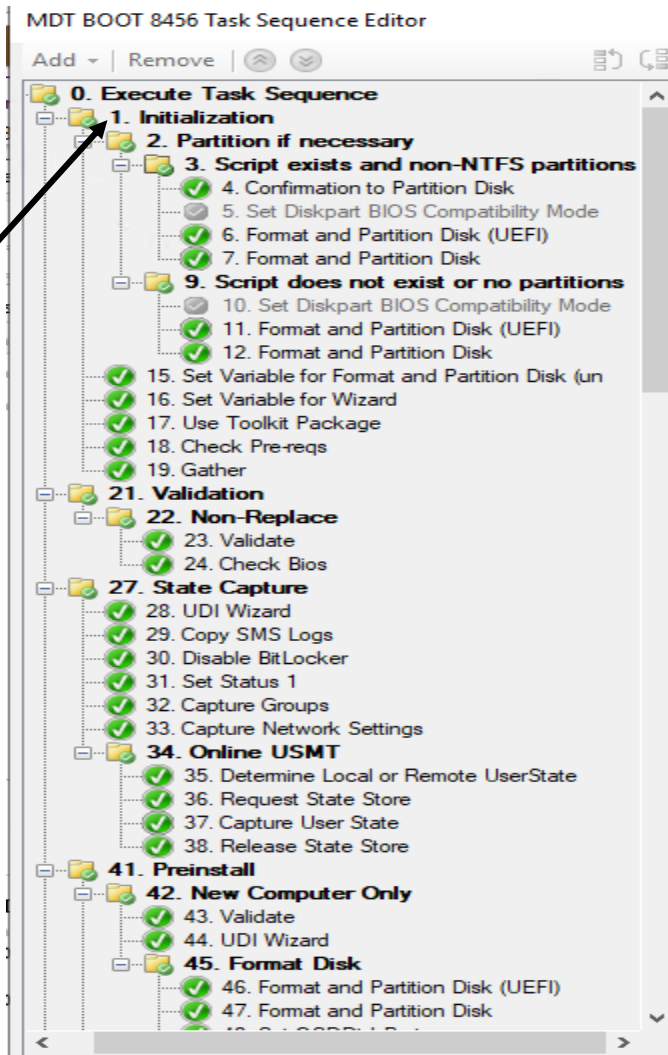
Now open Console and you will see new extension



To write step number for existing task sequence – Select the TS and click Write/Update Step numbers



After that you will see the following in the task sequence



With this extension it will be easy to troubleshoot error during build because smsts.log will contain the step number where the build failed and the reason.
