


Convert PowerShell script to EXE

I found this software that can convert PS script to EXE for easy deployment using SCCM. Just tried and it works well.

Extract the file – Run PS1 to EXE Generator. For this exercise, I copied a PS script to Documents folder.

Open this file



For Content Sources – Select Documents folder. Provide EXE Name. It will automatically select the PS script that is in the Documents folder. If you want to have an ICON for the EXE – select one and press Build the EXE. That is, it. The EXE file will be saved on the desktop.
