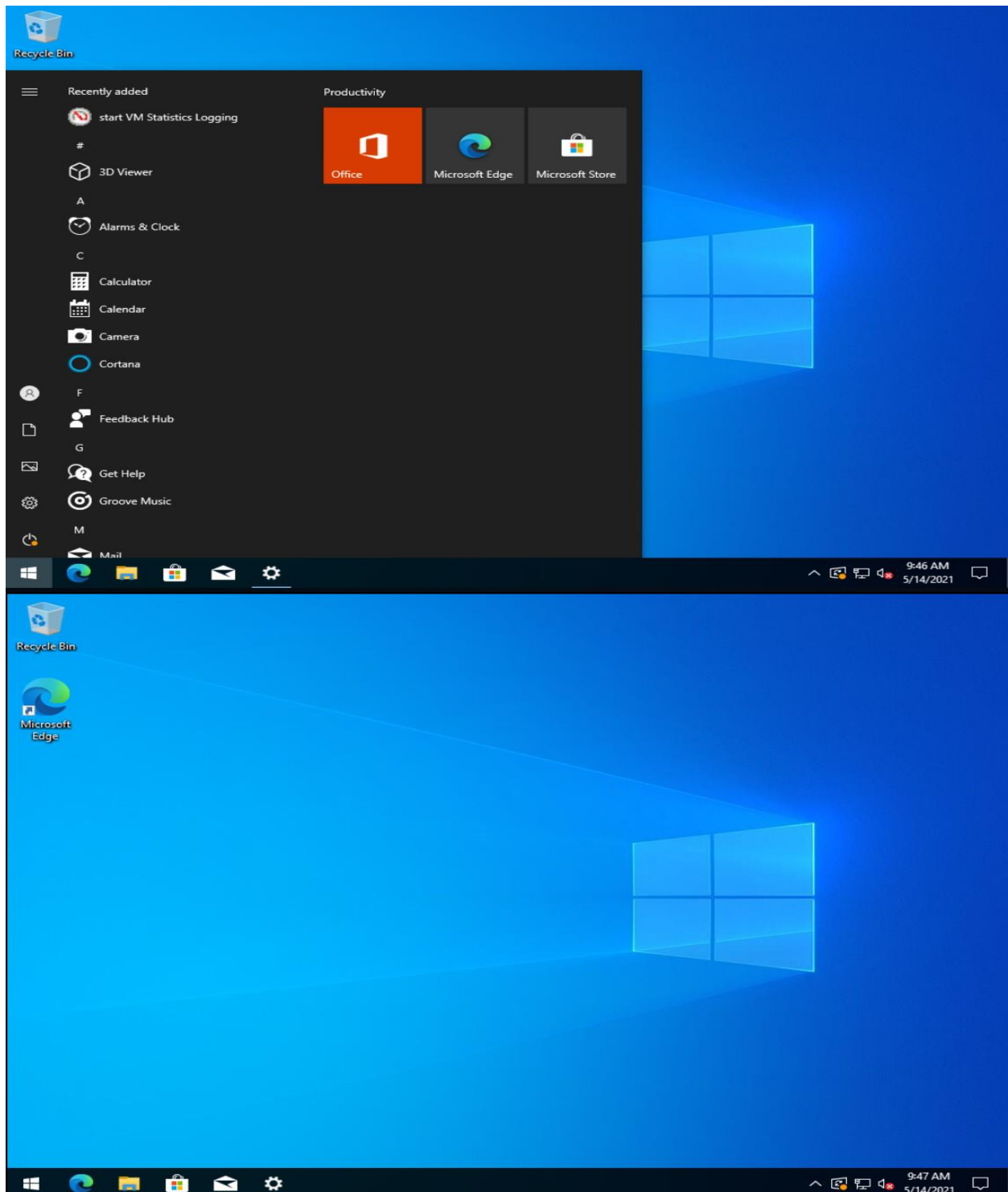


How to convert Win 10 OS from English to French

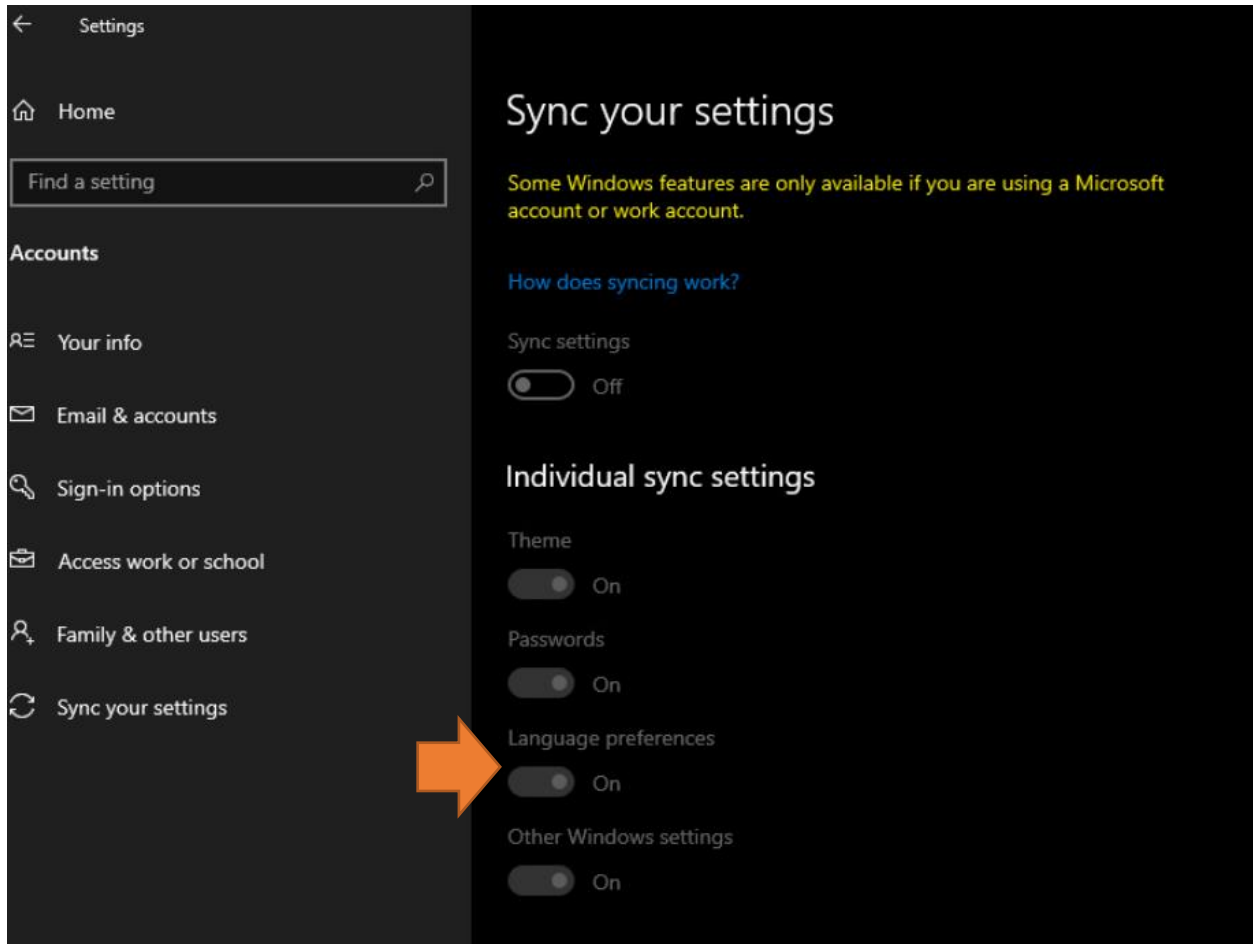
I am writing this post to share info with my team, how easy it is to convert OS from English to French after imaging.

At previous project, we had to image a lot of Lenovo AIO with English and French. On occasion, we do make mistake of deploying English version against French version. The only solution, we had was to reimage the desktop (AIO) which would take another 90 minutes. I wanted to share easy fix that can be done in less than 5 minutes. Here is the fix...

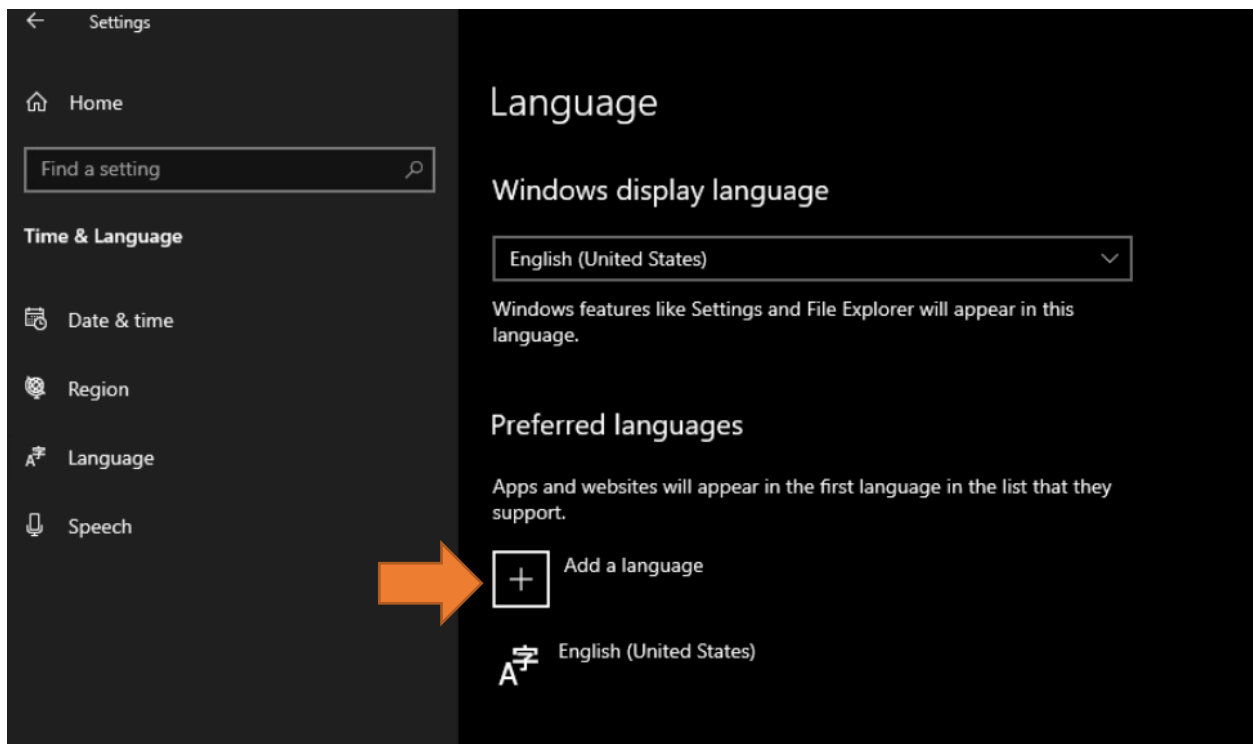
For this exercise, I created a VM and installed Win 10 English version. Now, I am going to change the OS to French version.

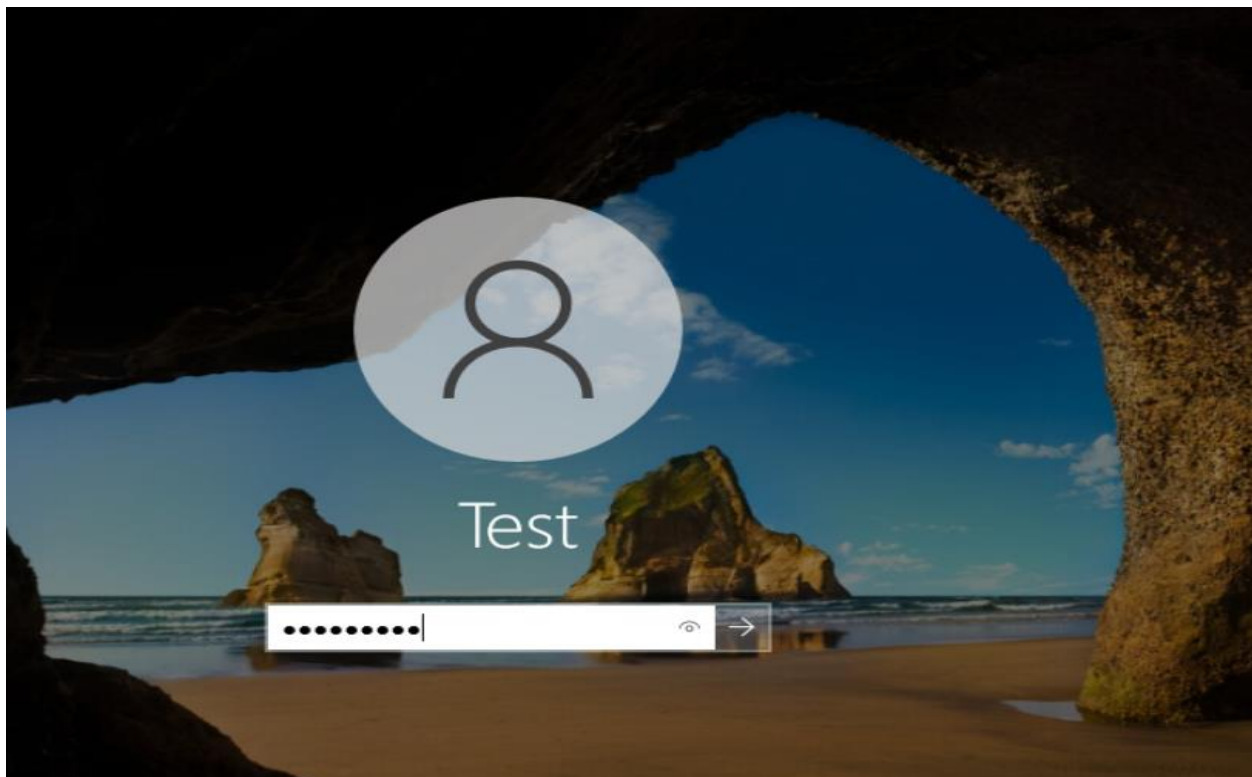
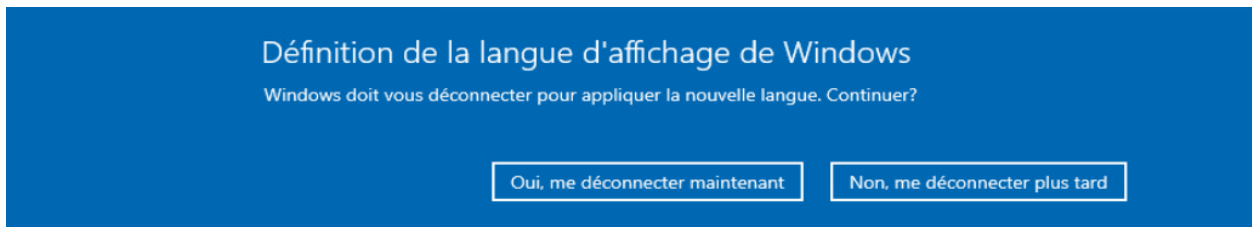




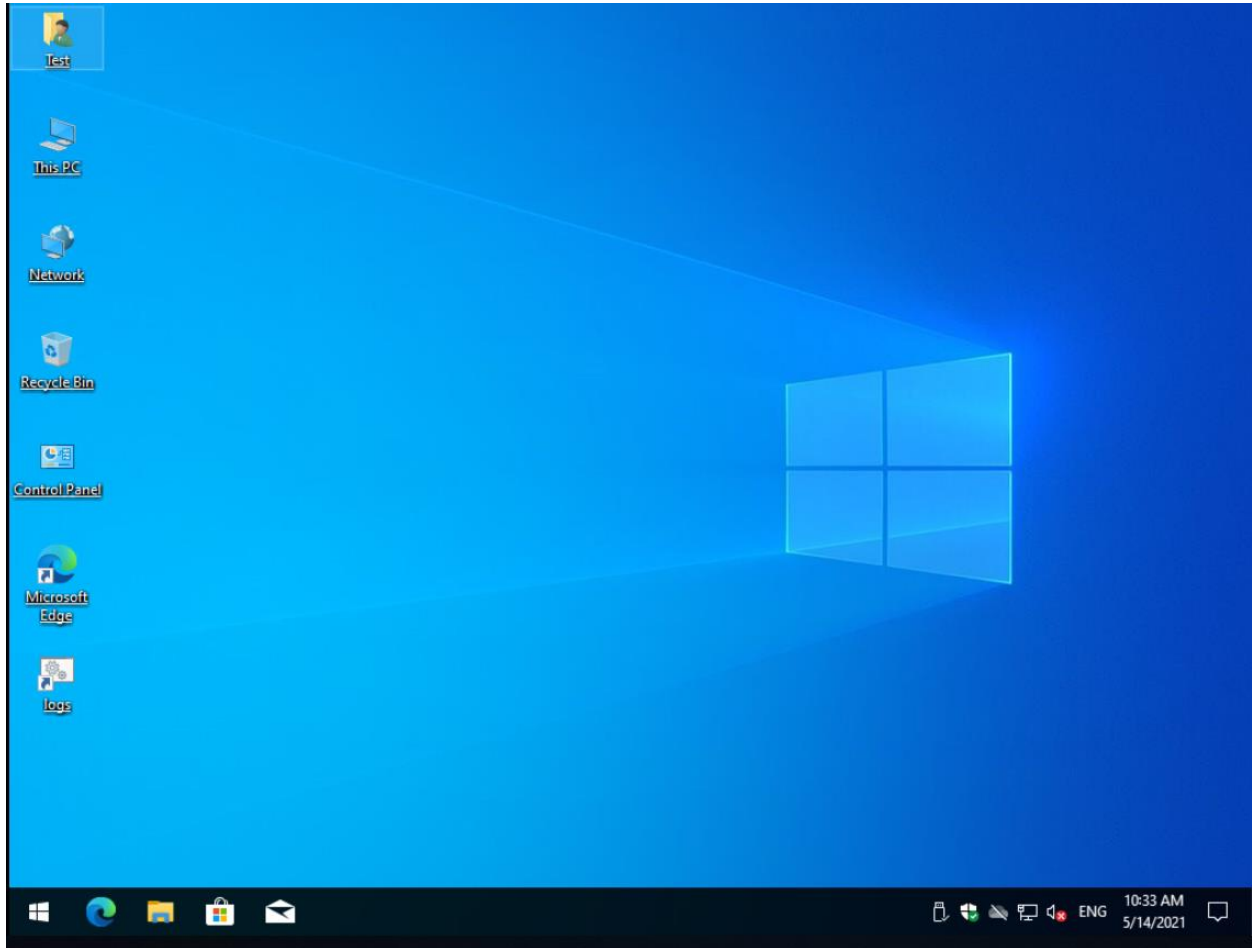
If you want to change back to English OS – Select English – United States
