
# How to make bootable USB for new Mac OS Monterey

In this post, I am going to show you the steps involved in creating bootable USB disk for above Mac OS. First download offline Mac OS installer from here




Select InstallAssistant.pkg – right click – Save link as to download folder. It will take some time to download due to the size (12GB).





After the download is complete – I copied the files to my MacBook Pro – Download folder.





Double click InstallAssistant.pkg












If you go to Applications folder you will see this...




Now plug in USB stick and open Disk Utility. Select USB stick




# Click Erase





Now open Applications and double click Install macOS Monterey and go to Resources folder



Here we see createinstallmedia command utility which we will be using it later for USB creation.

## Now open Terminal window



Type sudo and drag createinstallmedia inside terminal window and type -volume /Volumes/disk



The /Volumes/disk is our USB disk



Enter admin password and Press Y

If you wish to continue type (Y) then press return: y

It will take about 15 – 20 minutes to create bootable disk.

On MacBook desktop you will see this ICON - Select InstallmacOSMonterey – Command I and then go to Applications folder – Select InstallmacOSMonterey – Command I. Select this – copy and paste here








## This will change from this to this





## Now go to MacBook Pro Hard drive – Select USB disk and Eject



Now you have a working copy of USB stick with MacOS Monterey. You can use this for installing OS to a new Mac machine.
