7 ways to open Software Center


In this post, I am going to cover various way you can open Software Center. This is useful for IT support staff when they are performing remote support to users.

From any workstation Click Start - Type Software Center - Open it


SECOND:

From any workstation Click Start – Scroll Down – Look for Software Center – Open it




THIRD:

Click Start – Run – Type softwarecenter:




FOURTH:

Using Desktop Shortcut - Right click on your desktop - Click New Shortcut - Type below command


