How to install Sonoma Developer Beta

In this post, I am going to show the steps to install Sonoma MacOS on MacBook Pro. I am running MacOS Ventura



Ventura will be upgraded to Sonoma Beta. I am using Open Core Legacy Patcher to install Sonoma on unsupported MacBook Pro.

You can download Open Core Legacy Patcher from here

https://github.com/dortania/OpenCore-Legacy-Patcher/pull/1077

Move the file to Applications Folder and Open the patcher. Click create macOS installer.




Make sure to plug in USB stick with at least 64GB free space. Open Disk Utility to format USB drive. Make sure the format and scheme are exactly like the screen shot.




When you click Create macOS installer you will see these options. Click Download

Once the download is done click Create macOS installer and select USB disk.




Creating Installer: Install macOS Sonoma beta

We will notify you when the installer is ready.




When you click install to disk make sure to select USB Disk. After that you will be asked to reboot. While you reboot make sure to hold Options button to get to below screen and select EFI Boot




Now Select Install macOS Sonoma

Accept terms and conditions and select internal hard drive. Will take about 30-45 minutes to complete the install. The computer will restart few times. Wait for the task to complete. After that you will see below screens.
